

<u>United Lithium</u> announced a 4000m drill program at its Bergby Lithium project in Sweden. The program is designed to expand known lithium-bearing pegmatites along strike and depth, explore potential parallel zones, and test several lithium-bearing outcrops. The drill crews have already mobilized to Bergby, with the program expected to be concluded by end of July 23.



<u>Gungnir Resources</u> announced it is finalizing plans to conduct a 30-line kilometer EM survey on its Hemberget property, targeting shallow conductors in a large, layered mafic-ultramafic intrusion. A similar, but much smaller intrusion, previously discovered on the company's nearby Knaften property was found to contain magmatic sulfide mineralization.
