

<u>QX Resources</u> announced it secured 39% of Bayrock Resources Limited, controlling a portfolio of nickel-cobalt-copper projects in Sweden. Following drilling at the Lainejaur prospect, Bayrock has now mobilized a drill rig to the Vuostok project, where historic drilling intersected flat-lying, near-surface nickel-copper mineralization. Approximately 15 shallow holes for a total of around 450m are planned to be drilled at the prospect.



Bayrock Projects in Northern Sweden (Source: www.qxresources.com.au)



Industry News

<u>Avira Resources</u> announced that a SkyTEM survey at the Puolalaki project is to commence shortly. The heliborne survey aims to screen the entire project area for moderate-strong conductors down to a depth of 100-200m – below the depth penetration of historically used slingram methods.

Logging of the holes drilled in April is progressing steadily with holes PUO23005 and PUO23001 now in the lab for assaying.
