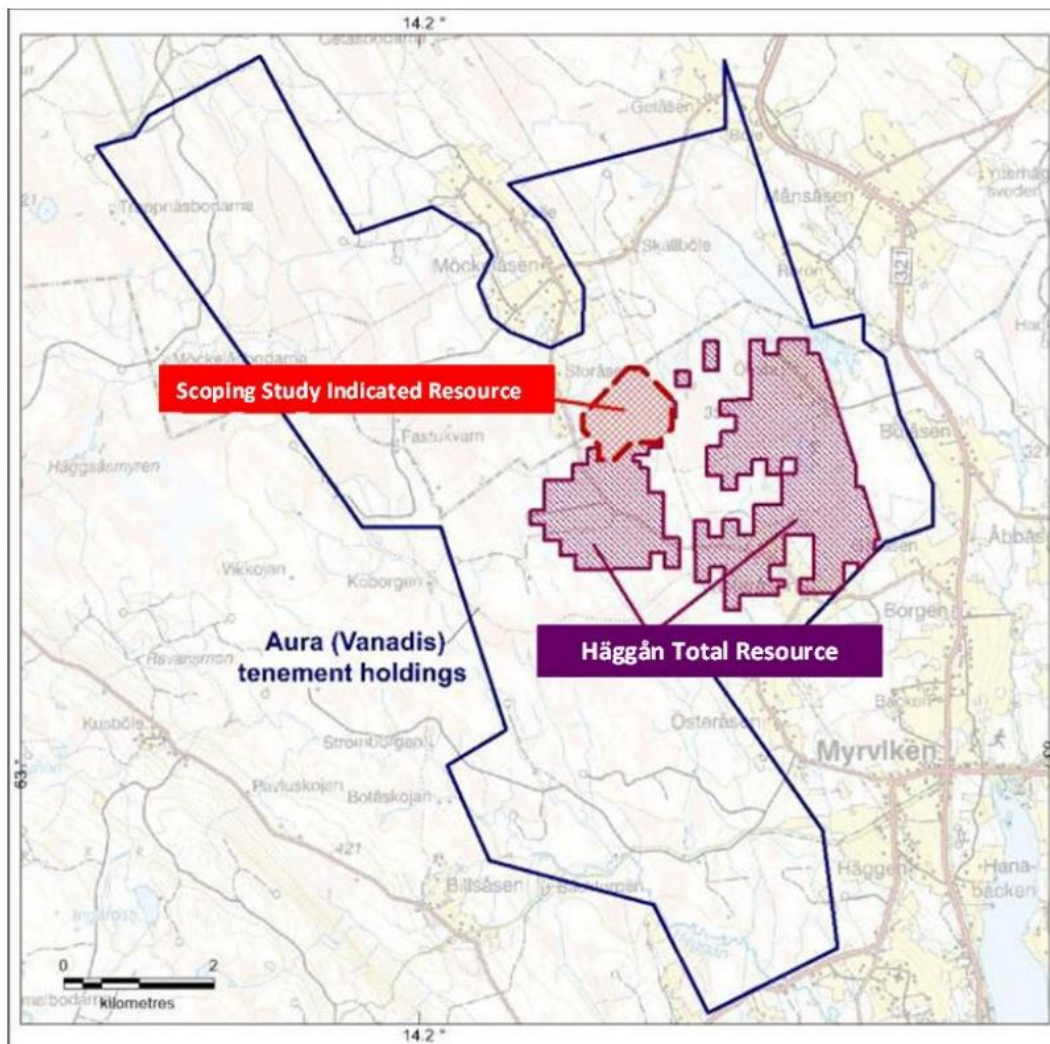

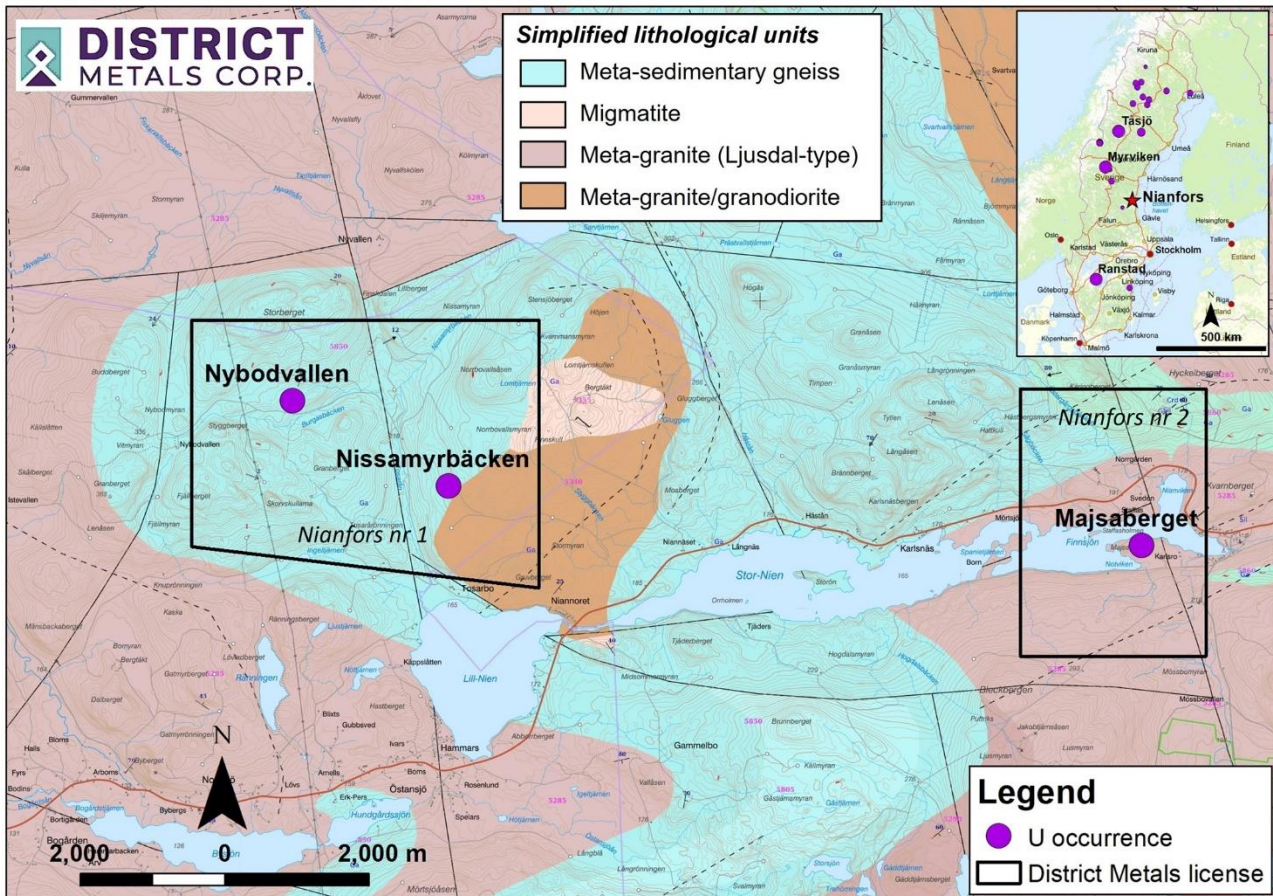
Aura Energy released a scoping study covering parts of its polymetallic Häggån project in Sweden. The study is based on a 65Mt case scenario, representing only 3% of Häggån's total 2Bt mineral resource estimate, and aims to recover vanadium, potash, nickel, molybdenum, zinc, and depending on the legal situation in Sweden and community approval, uranium. The company notes that it plans to advance the project with an application for an exploitation concession which will include several baseline studies and a pre-feasibility study, including for example further resource and infill drilling.

Industry News

District Metals announced it was granted the Nianfors nr1 and nr2 exploration licenses located in Gävleborgs County, central Sweden. The Nianfors nr2 license contains the Majsaberget uranium-yttrium-molybdenum occurrence, consisting of 889 mineralized boulders that returned a weighted average of 0.16% U_3O_8 and 0.08% Y. In addition, several mineralized outcrops also occur, indicating a mineralized zone with widths greater than 4m and historic assays of 0.27% U_3O_8 and 0.1% Y. Although strongly recommended by previous explorers, diamond drilling has never been conducted at the property.
